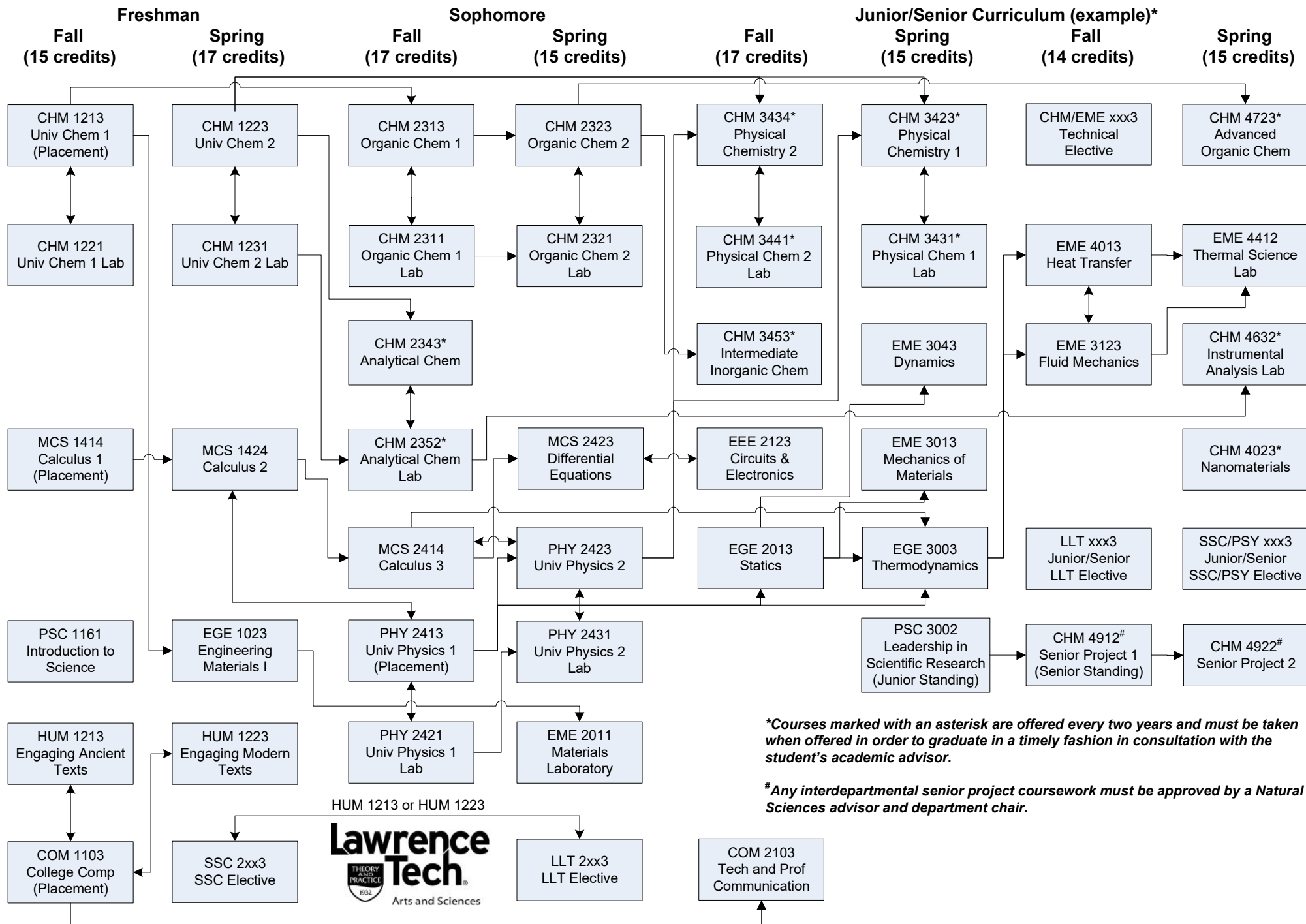


# Bachelor of Science in Chemistry with a concentration in Engineering Chemistry (125 credits)
