Our hopes for a greenway in downtown Ann Arbor were revived in 2004 with expressions of interest on the part of key figures in the development community, the Department of Parks and Recreation, regional land trusts, and the public. We incorporated the group in the State of Michigan in September 2005 as the Allen Creek Greenway Conservancy. We have been granted 501.3.c status under federal law and have created a proposed route for the Greenway.

Urban Design Advocates

Ann Arbor, Michigan, 2000-2002

UDA, an ad hoc urban design action group, prepared a "Greater Downtown Ann Arbor Urban Design Principles and Checklist" as a guide for citizens, developers, and civic officials in March 2000. We also met with the Democratic (majority) caucus of the Ann Arbor City Council to promote a thoughtful approach to the proposed expansion of City Hall. In 2002, we developed a "Prospectus for an Ann Arbor Downtown Greenway" which also addressed storm water issues associated with Allen's Creek.

Currently, I serve on the groups SkyTrail Subcommittee, which has commissioned inForm Architects to prepare a design for a bridge that would link the Greenway to the Huron River.

Property Planning Committee / Huron Valley Girl Scout Council Ann Arbor, Michigan, Fall 2001-Spring 2002

The Property Planning Committee was appointed by the HVGSC Board to study and prepare a set of recommendations for the development of the Council's three camps over the next 20 years.
