



LTU STUDENT GOVERNMENT 2025 PRESIDENT/VP APPLICATION & CAMPAIGNING INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY

President:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on the 4.0 grade point system
- A minimum of 60 credit hours completed overall
- A minimum of 30 credit hours completed at Lawrence Technological University in Southfield, MI.
- A Senate member for a minimum of one semester
- Attended one Executive Board meeting, at the discretion of the Executive Board
- Must be enrolled full-time at the Lawrence Technological University in Southfield, MI.

Vice-President:

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 on the 4.0 grade point system
- A minimum of 50 credit hours completed overall
- A minimum of 25 credit hours completed at Lawrence Technological University in Southfield, MI
- A Senate member for a minimum of one semester
- Attended one Executive Board meeting, at the discretion of the Executive Board
- Must be enrolled full-time at the Lawrence Technological University in Southfield, MI

2025 APPLICATION & ELECTION PROCESS

- ★ Deadline to Apply – **Monday, March 24th @ 11:59pm**. This consists of submitting:
 - Application form
 - Nomination Petition (consisting of 50 endorsements must be submitted (digitally) to the current Student Government Election Committee. It can also be emailed to stugov@ltu.edu.)
 - These documents will be emailed via the Dean of Students.

- ★ Campaigning begins once each party is notified that they are eligible to run
 - All candidates will be screened for eligibility before approval to begin campaigning
 - All campaign materials must be approved by the Division of Student Affairs
 - All campaign materials must be taken down by the end of the election week
- ★ Candidate Debate – **Tuesday, April 1st @ 12:30pm**
 - Updates will be posted as we move closer to campaign week
 - Candidates will be emailed with details
- ★ Election Day – **Tuesday, April 8th** (open until 11:59pm)
