LTU's annual scholarship and financial aid support continues to grow to meet the needs of our students. We have continued to provide over 35 million dollars each year to our students from the universities operating budget. We established new scholarships to support our students all over the State of Michigan and we continue to increase the giving of our alumni to support our students.
