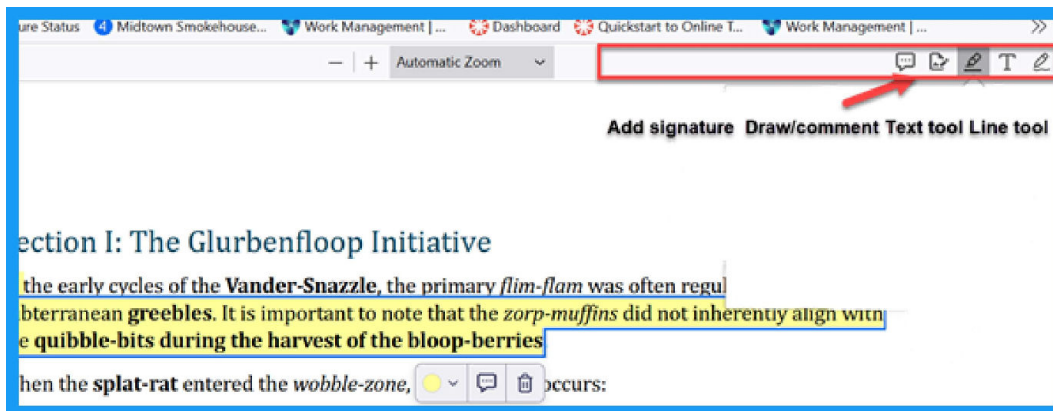


Use Firefox to edit a PDF:

- **Opening PDFs:** To open a PDF in Firefox, navigate through the menu to "File" then "Open File" or use the **Ctrl + O** shortcut.



- **Filling Out Forms:** Firefox allows users to type directly into fillable fields and use the **Tab** key to navigate between lines.
- **Built-in Annotation Tools:** Firefox includes a toolbar at the top of the browser with options to **comment, highlight, add text boxes, draw, and add images.**
- **Adding Signatures:** Users can add a signature by selecting the "Add Signature" tool, typing their name or selecting a saved signature, and placing/resizing it on the document.



- **Saving and Splitting:** To save changes, use the **Print** icon or **Ctrl + P** and select "Save to PDF" as the destination. To split a file, choose "Custom" under the pages option and select specific page ranges to save.
